



Exam voucher offer for CREST USA and CREST Americas

As a reflection of our continued support for the professionalization of the cyber security industry in the USA and Canada, and the further growth and development of the skills base, CREST is offering a series of discounts on CPSA (CREST Practitioner Security Analyst), CRT (CREST Registered Penetration Tester) and CCT (CREST Certified Tester) exams to existing CREST members as well as organizations planning to become a CREST member in the USA or the Americas¹.

The discounts are available up to December 31, 2018.

There are two packages of offers with the following discount vouchers:

Offer One

- 5 CPSA exam vouchers – discounting the exam to \$250 USD
- 5 CRT exam vouchers – discounting the exam to \$350 USD
- 5 CCT practical exam vouchers – discounting the exam to \$1,000 USD

The total cost is just \$8000, compared to the normal cost of \$17,087.

Offer Two

- 5 CPSA exam vouchers – discounting the exam to \$250 USD
- 5 CRT exam vouchers – discounting the exam to \$350 USD

The total is \$3000, compared to the normal cost of \$4,962.50.

Discounts are redeemable on the practical elements of CRT and CCT only. CCT written elements are charged at published rates.

How it works

CREST will issue each organization with vouchers for the CPSA exams and discount codes for the CRT and CCT exams. These will allow the exams to be booked at the reduced rate. They will be valid for 12 months from the date of issue.

The offer is available for exams taken at Pearson Vue centers in the USA and Canada and at the CREST (USA) Exam Center in New York City, subject to availability. Members are not obliged to purchase any exams.
